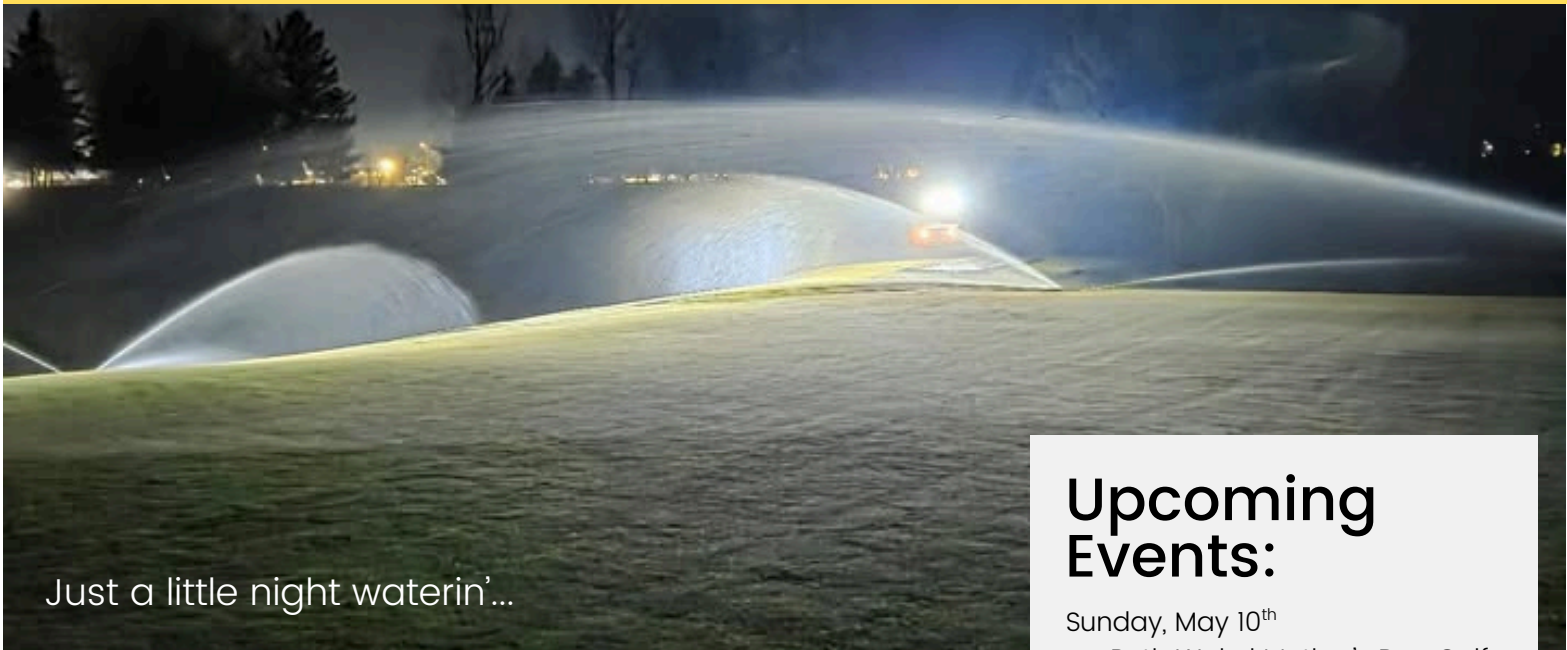

Course Update 🏌️

Spring is here! and with it the hope of the golf course surviving winters fury. We are very fortunate that this year, the three greens that need the most TLC, #4, #6, and #7 were covered with a new tarping system. This is a very common method used by many courses with tremendous success. We are happy to report that our three best greens are now #4, #6, and #7, which came through 100%! This winter was extremely challenging with two major freeze thaw cycles that could have caused way more damage then they did. With the huge amount of snow over the winter we were able to see the pond fill to capacity, which puts us in a great position to start the year in a very good spot. The maintenance department is looking forward to seeing familiar faces as well as new ones as we kick off the golf season!

President's Message

Hello everyone,

Golf season is officially here—finally. While the weather seemed determined to keep us in “extended winter training mode,” we’re thrilled to say the course is now open and looking fantastic. The greens came through beautifully, thanks to Jerry and his crew, who once again worked their magic to get everything ready for spring. If you see them out there, feel free to offer a high-five, a thank-you, or baked goods of any kind.

Hole #8 Pond Restoration – Big News!

We also have some truly exciting news to share about Hole #8. After months of work, conversations, and several presentations to city council, we have successfully secured both a gift and a loan from the City for the restoration of the pond. The City has approved 50% of the project cost as a direct contribution, and the remaining 50% as a 10-year loan at 0% financing. Even better—our lease will remain unchanged for the duration of that loan.

This is a major win for the club. With this support, we can finally stabilize the pond, retain water properly, and protect one of the most important features of our course. Work is scheduled for the fall, and we’ll keep everyone updated as we move forward.

Clubhouse Renovations – A Fresh New Look

If you’ve stepped inside recently, you’ve likely noticed that our kitchen and dining area look completely transformed. New floors, cabinets, paint, countertops, lighting, sound, and a long list of other upgrades have brought new life to the space.
