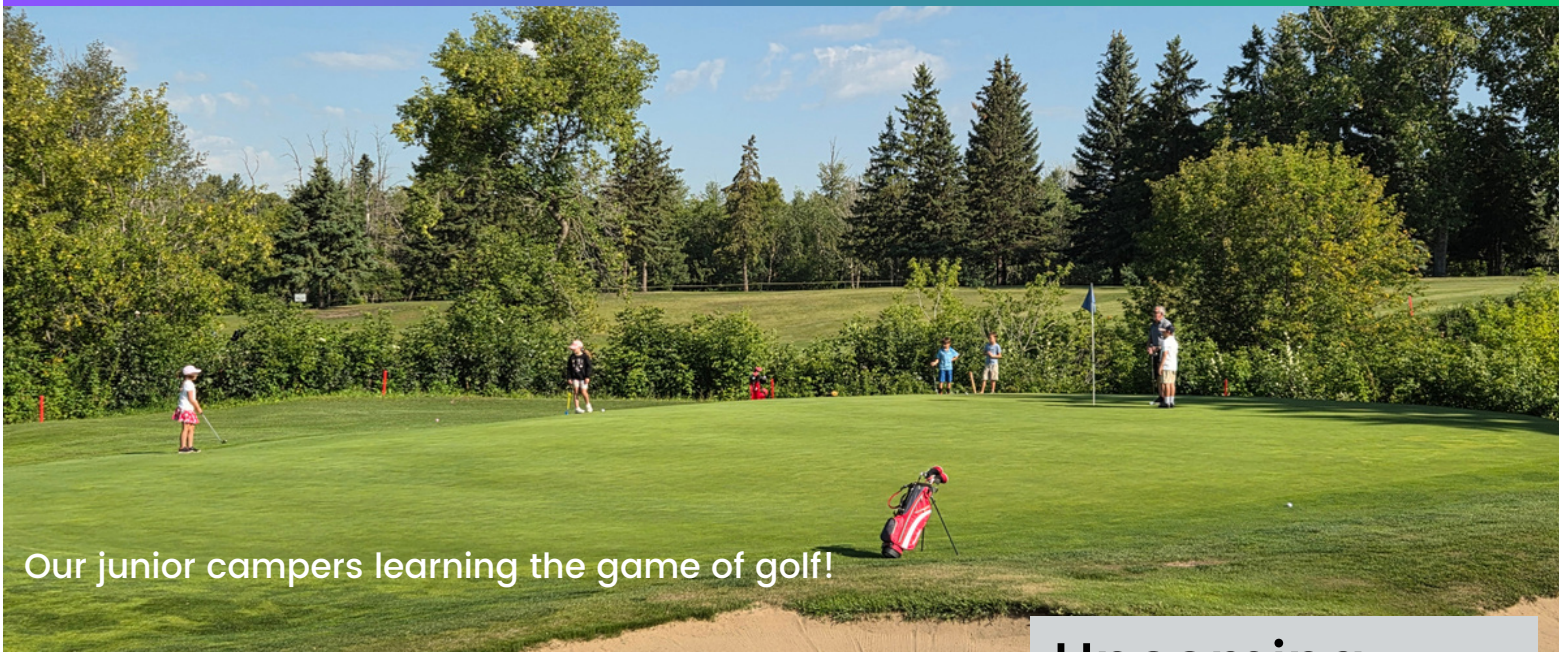

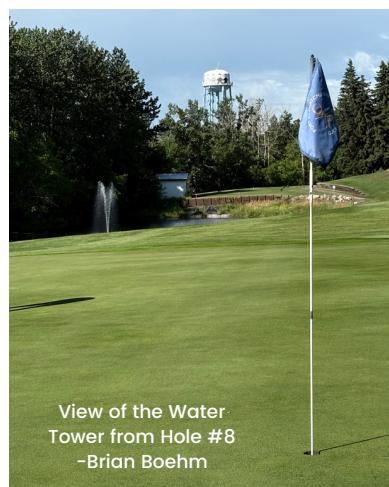
What's up?

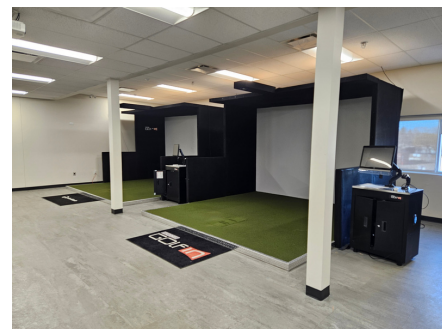
2025-26 Curling Season
