TOURNAMENT GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

Fort Saskatchewan Golf and Curling Club Resort strives to deliver exceptional customer service, and the following terms and conditions are in place to ensure that your experience with us reflects the vision that you have for your event. Please read the following terms and conditions carefully. We look forward to offering our assistance during the planning and execution of your tournament. Thank you for choosing Fort Saskatchewan Golf and Curling Club.

1) CONTRACTS, DEPOSITS, PAYMENTS, CANCELLATIONS

- a) All events require a signed agreement and payment of the required deposit to confirm event.
- b) For subsequent payments, Fort Saskatchewan Golf and Curling Club requires a valid credit card number on file (Visa, or MasterCard).
- c) The credit card number on file **MUST** be valid through the event date.
- d) Initial deposit and all subsequent payments are non-refundable but may be transferable once received by Fort Saskatchewan Golf and Curling Club
- e) Cancellations of the event must be received via email to the Events Manager and must be received no later than 7 days prior to the event date.
- f) The tournament will proceed as scheduled unless the Course Superintendent deems the golf course unplayable. If the course is unplayable, the event may be rescheduled; or if unable to reschedule, then the banquet is to proceed, and rain cheques will be issued for all confirmed attendees to use at a later date.

- g) After the event date, Fort Saskatchewan Golf and Curling Club will allow 3 business days for making inquiries regarding your final invoice, and 7 business days to settle any unpaid charges from your event.

2) FOOD AND BEVERAGE

- a) Due to licensing requirements by Alberta Health Services and for quality control issues, all food & beverage served on premises must be supplied by Fort Saskatchewan Golf and Curling Club, unless alternate arrangements have been made.
- b) To comply with all health & safety regulations set out by AHS and the AGLC (Alberta Gaming & Liquor Commission), Fort Saskatchewan Golf and Curling Club prohibits the removal of any food or beverage from the premises following an event.
- c) Fort Saskatchewan Golf and Curling Club strictly adheres to all laws and regulations set out by the AGLC.
- d) All meal sponsorships, food & beverage holes, and liquor sponsorships must be pre-approved by your Events Manager at least 7 days prior to the tournament.
- e) Liquor sponsorships may be subject to additional fees for the sale and/or service of liquor on premises. Fees will be applied to your final invoice. Fort Saskatchewan Golf and Curling Club will not be responsible for collecting fees from any sponsors, unless alternate arrangements have been made.
- f) Tournament attendees shall not bring or consume any liquor on the premises that has not been purchased through Fort Saskatchewan Golf and Curling Club
- g) Fort Saskatchewan Golf and Curling Club reserves the right to end alcohol service at any time if outside alcoholic beverages are being consumed by your attendees on premises; and/or a \$150 fee may be added to your final invoice for each occurrence.
- h) Prizes that include alcoholic beverages will be held at the Fort Saskatchewan Golf and Curling Club administrative office and returned to you or your guests at time of departure.
- i) Fort Saskatchewan Golf and Curling Club reserves the right to cut off alcohol service at any time, either to individual guest(s) or to the entire event, should any guest(s) become over-intoxicated, belligerent, disrespectful of staff or other guests, if any instance of harassment occurs, or for any other reason that our staff deems necessary as per AGLC requirements.
- j) A 15% gratuity charge plus all applicable provincial and federal government taxes will be applied to additional food & beverage items added to event booking (outside of food & beverage that is already included in your tournament package).

3) GUARANTEES

- a) A tentative player count is required at the time of contract signing.
- b) Final number of players and additional guests/volunteers and meal selection options **MUST** be confirmed via email 7 days prior to your tournament.
- c) The guaranteed number of players quoted 14 days prior is not subject to reduction. Any increase to this count within 14 days of the event must be pre-approved by your Events Manager.
- d) Event billing will be based on the guaranteed number of players and meal selection options and will be charged to the credit card on file 7 days prior to the event date.

- e) All sponsorships must be approved and confirmed 7 days prior to the tournament date. We reserve the right to decline sponsorship requests or apply fees where applicable.

4) TOURNAMENT SPECIFICS

- a) Dress Code: Fort Saskatchewan Golf and Curling Club does not allow denim of any kind, athletic wear such as sweatpants or track pants, board or skater shorts. Proper golf shoes with soft spikes or sneakers must be worn, and flip flops or bare feet are not permitted.
- b) Excessively slow play will not be tolerated. The Course Marshal is directed to remind groups when their play is slow. The Course Marshal has full authority to move groups if necessary to increase speed of play and improve the enjoyment of others.
- c) It is the responsibility of the tournament to remind all players to observe proper golf etiquette; ie. repair ball marks, fix divots, rake traps, etc. Any player not displaying proper etiquette may be removed from the course.

5) SECURITY, FACILITY LIMITATIONS, MISCELLANEOUS

- a) Fort Saskatchewan Golf and Curling Club is not responsible for the performance or execution of any third party AV presentation or equipment.
- b) Fort Saskatchewan Golf and Curling Club is not responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged personal items while on the premises prior to, during or following your event.
- c) The tournament acknowledges and accepts financial responsibility for any damage to the golf course, golf carts, clubhouse, or any other part of the facility or property of Fort Saskatchewan Golf and Curling Club that is caused by your tournament participants, vendors, sponsors or volunteers. All applicable repair costs and/or service charges will be applied to your final invoice.
- d) Smoking is permitted in designated areas only at Fort Saskatchewan Golf and Curling Club. Smoking is prohibited on all patios.
- e) Our Events Manager must be notified of all deliveries in order to arrange times for access to the clubhouse and appropriate storage space.
- f) Fort Saskatchewan Golf and Curling Club reserves the right to inspect and regulate all events. This includes but is not limited to: the right to deny entry to or remove from the property any guest(s) or event vendor(s) whose behavior or demeanor is not conducive to the enjoyment or safety of patrons or staff. Aggressive or abusive behavior and/or any illegal activity will not be tolerated.
- g) Terms and Conditions are subject to change without notice.
