## Course Update 🏌️

June is here. It's the official start of summer! This is the time of year when the turf hits a new gear in its growth cycle. The longest day of the year is June 21st so the added sunlight is fantastic to maximize growing conditions. June historically is also the wettest month of the year for rainfall. This increased rainfall means that the golf course can rely less on outside water. Another benefit of more rain is that rain water is packed with more nutrients than outside water, including being nitrogen-rich. On the maintenance side of things this is also where cultural practices start to ramp up with aeration, top dressing and verticutting (vertical mowing). All of these practices contribute to a high quality playing surface on the green, for you the golfer!
