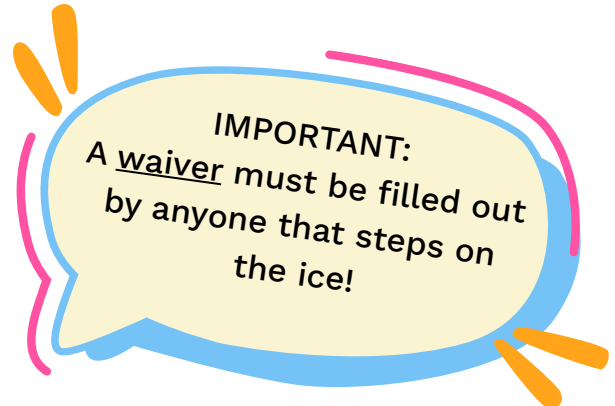
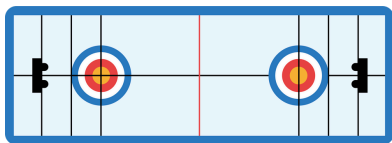

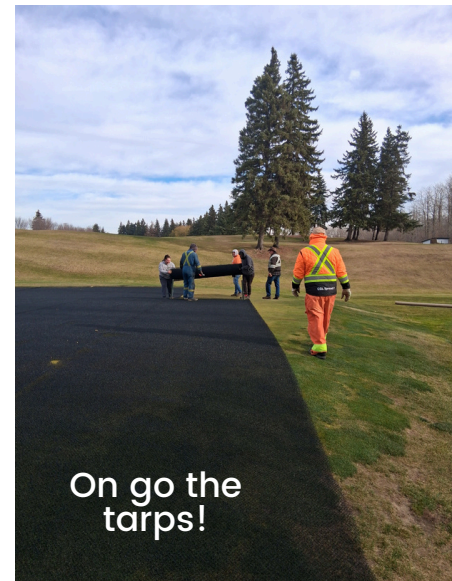

Course Update

The end of the season is upon us and with it the final steps in preparing the course for winter. The greens this year were aerated with a solid star tine 6 inches in length. This depth will help in the spring time to give the roots a new channel to grow into. Fungicide has been sprayed to all greens, tees, and fairways. Greens 4, 6, and 7 have the new tarp system put down which will help dramatically reduce any chance of winter injury. The rest of the greens got a medium amount of sand to help from freezer type winds that cause turf burn. Leaves have been blown into channels and the rough mower then has mulched them up, so there will be no clean up other than branches in the spring. Lastly, the irrigation system has been blown out and the pump house winterized. The recent rains have really helped out with turf quality. We are now looking pretty good, all things considered, for this time of year. Thank you to all of our members and guests, the maintenance department looks forward to seeing you all again next year!
